- Identify the product master data required for EU FMD:
 - » Identify the components of a GTIN and an NTIN.
 - » Describe the multinational product coding structures allowed under EU FMD.
 - » List the coding types different EU FMD-compliant countries are using for their products.
- Describe EU FMD requirements for multi-market packs.
- Specify product master data for multi-market packs.
- Understand how to enter the data that the EMVS expects into the TraceLink Master Data Exchange application.
- Map TraceLink Master Data Exchange fields to TraceLink EU Compliance report fields and to the EU Hub fields.
