UI Features

The following new or updated functionality will be included in this release.

Enhancements to Company Identifiers for Company, Partner, and their Locations

This feature introduces new EMVS identifiers for Owners that are subject to EU and EU FMD compliance regulations, and US pharmaceutical supply chain identifiers for Multienterprise Information Network Tower (MINT) Owners. Owners can use the new in Product master data to meet compliance reporting requirements for various countries in which a product is manufactured or sold. The following identifier types are added:

- EU SPOR ORG ID An identifier used for a company that performs tracking activities for substances, products, organisations and referentials (SPOR) to support EU regulatory activities.
- EU SPOR LOC ID An identifier used by a company location that performs tracking activities for substances, products, organisations and referentials (SPOR) to support EU regulatory activities.
- 340B ID An identifier used to assign a unique value by the Office of Pharmacy Affairs (OPA) for each covered entity parent or child site to a company, company location, Partner, or Partner location.
- PHARMACY PROCESSOR NUMBER An identifier used to assign a unique value

to each pharmacy for submitting claims to a company, company location, Partner, or Partner location.

• SCAC – An identifier used to assign a unique value to identify transportation carriers for a company, company location, or Partner.
