

Russia Serialization Requirements

- Serialisation is at the Secondary (Saleable Unit) and Tertiary (Case) level
 - Aggregation required
- Multiple barcode options
 - 2D DataMatrix code (secondary)
 - Linear 128 (tertiary) [with 2D DataMatrix in special situations]
- Unique Identifier (secondary) contains five key data elements
 - GTIN (GTIN-14)
 - GTIN uniquely assigned per packaging site (OR)
 - GTIN common for all sites with unique SubjectID per site for reporting
 - Serial Number
 - Randomized (1:10,000), alphanumeric, 13 chars (under review)
 - FEACN code (Foreign Economic Activity Commodity Nomenclature)
 - 4 digits (first 4 of the 10 digit FEACN code)
 - Batch Number
 - Expiration Date
- Product Identifier Uniqueness (MAH)
 - 1 year after expiry date of pack (or) 5 years after pack has been introduced into the supply chain

April 2020 Update: The current compliance deadline for all medicines manufactured in Russia or imported into Russia is July 1, 2020. As of December 31, 2019, medicines that fall under the government's HCN/7 Nosologies guidelines are expected to comply with the current serialization requirements, which comprise 4 elements: Product Code (GTIN), Serial Number, Crypto Key, and Crypto Code.
